*IV. Meta Mesh Grant Application (Adam Longwill)*

MetaMesh has submitted a \$15,000 grant to Neighborhood Allies for 20 wi-fi routers to provide public wi-fi in the business district. Since the business district is relatively small, 20 routers will provide backup and reserves for expansion.

How does the system prevent people from monopolizing your internet connection? Your traffic gets priority on your own connection. Any excess bandwidth you have is donated.

Lisa motioned to support MetaMesh's grant application, Alana second, unanimously approved.
