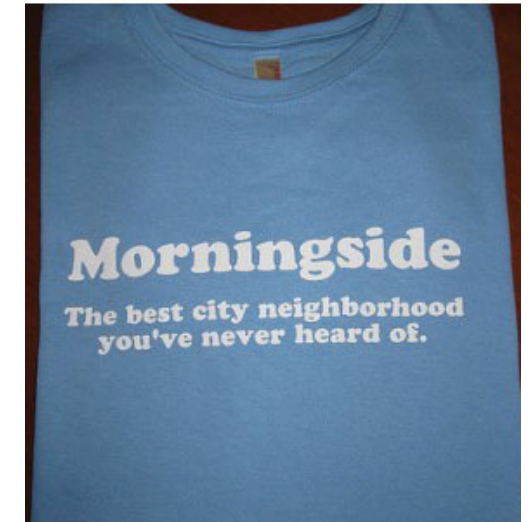

Winter is officially here and we have received many inquiries about the new City of Pittsburgh Winter Weather Emergency Resource Guide produced by the Office of the Mayor and the Department of Public Works. It provides vital information about both routine and emergency snow removal operations and presents the new snow emergency routes.
