

**Morningside Area Community Council Monthly Meeting**  
**August 7, 2019 Draft Minutes**  
**Citiparks Healthy Active Living Center, Morningside**

I. Called to order 7:08. Pledge of Allegiance.

II. Public Safety. Our new zone commander, Stephen Vinansky introduced himself. Officer McNeill took questions.

III. Elected Officials

- A. Ernest presented from the Mayor's Community office. Programs detailed were the Civic Leadership Academy, new city eWaste recycling program, the URA's Neighborhood Initiatives Fund, the Dolly Parton Imagination Library reading program for children. He sought feedback on the old Natoli Field Recreation building. The consensus was that the original use as a resource for the neighborhood youth should be considered. All felt that the facility should offer community programming. Questions were asked about administration and access and whether there might be more flexible ways of scheduling time than requiring a city staff supervisor to be present.
- B. Rep. Innamorato's office made announcements including that they now have the ability to issue 4-year senior bus passes at their offices at 5154 Butler Street.
- C. Abby Ray from Deb Gross' office presented and introduced a new office staffer, Dan. The Heth's Run walkthrough was discussed. Lead line replacement was discussed as well, and she reported that the PWSA board has accepted her request that all lead lines be replaced as part of future work. They have a new utilities coordinator in their office. Community questions were fielded regarding. Order was suspended to review the traffic calming measures individually in small groups.

V. Committee Reports

- A. Events: October 20th may be a Bulldog-centered street event that will involve a street closure, and will showcase local businesses.
